Mr. Allmon reported on behalf of the Security Committee. The National Sheriff's Association now coordinates the National Neighborhood Watch program. Through it, we can set up a Neighborhood Watch Group and order neighborhood watch signs for \$22 each, which KCMO Public Works would install for free. Almond also discussed the idea of a mid-year membership drive and promoting the WPHA via yard signs.
